PRELIMINARY HEARING NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, the Stevens County Board of Commissioners, sitting as the public drainage authority for Stevens County Ditch 16, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 103E.261, shall hold a public hearing on the preliminary engineer's report. The hearing will be held at 6:30 p.m. on July 20, 2021 in the Commissioners' Board Room of the Stevens County Courthouse, 400 Colorado Ave, Morris, Minnesota 56267; however, the Board of Commissioners has determined, based on the State Emergency Declaration related to the COVID-19 health pandemic, that it may not be practical nor prudent to hold solely in-person meetings during the emergency and health pandemic.
