The special meeting of the Stevens County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 8:30 a.m., Friday, April 14, 2023, by Chair Jeanne Ennen. Members in attendance were Ennen, Kopitzke and Staples. Absent: Wohlers and Lesmeister-Nelson

WHEREAS the event has caused a significant amount of public property damage; and

WHEREAS the Stevens County Department of Emergency Management requests the Stevens County Board of Commissioners to declare Stevens County in a STATE OF EMERGENCY for the flooding event on April 12, 2023.

WHEREAS the Board Chair – Jeanne Ennen declared a State of Emergency on behalf of the residents of Stevens County on the 12th day of April 2023;




Adopted by the Stevens County Board of Commissioners Chairman on this 14th day of April 2023.
